

PENTHOUSE AMSTERDAM

The large surface of this penthouse on the third floor of a canal house in the center of Amsterdam requested an open attitude. Thanks to some bold architectural interventions, the potential of different spaces were uncovered. The 30-foot (9-meter) kitchen and the large fireplace in the living area catch the eye, as well as the kitchen island with integrated dining table. With their large dimensions, they bring balance and peace to the interior. The sofa, table, and grey carpet are comfortable but luxurious. The bathroom and storage space are located behind a façade. The darker shade contrasts with the light floor. Thereby, the effect of the interventions is

emphasized. In the bedroom, the main colors used are white and brown. There are no extra decorations in the bedroom, presenting a sense of simplicity. From furniture and accessories to layout and architecture, the starting point for Remy Meijers in all his interior design was finding perfectly matching elements. That is why he almost always chooses furniture and accessories that he designs himself. Some of these items can be found in this project as well.
